Digging Deeper Verses (NLT) - draw or write your thoughts about each verse

Matthew 28:18-19 - “Jesus came and told his disciples, “I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.”” **A disciple is one who follows a leader or teacher. What does Jesus mean when he says to go and make disciples?**

Acts 1:6-8 - “So when the apostles were with Jesus, they kept asking him, “Lord, has the time come for you to free Israel and restore our kingdom?” He replied, “The Father alone has the authority to set those dates and times, and they are not for you to know. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”” **Think about Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and the ends of the earth geographically. How can we apply this to our lives and where we live?**

Romans 10:13-15 - “For “Everyone who calls on the name of the LORD will be saved.” But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them? And how will anyone go and tell them without being sent? That is why the Scriptures say, “How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news!”” **For a person to believe in Jesus, what do these verses tell us must happen?**
