Digging Deeper Verses (NLT) - draw or write your thoughts about each verse

How did God save Jonah?

Jonah 1:17 - "Now the LORD had arranged for a great fish to swallow Jonah. And Jonah was inside the fish for three days and three nights."

Jonah 2:10 - "Then the LORD ordered the fish to spit Jonah out onto the beach."

How did God save us?

Matthew 12:40 - "For as Jonah was in the belly of the great fish for three days and three nights, so will the Son of Man be in the heart of the earth for three days and three nights."

1 Corinthians 15:3-4 - "I passed on to you what was most important and what had also been passed on to me. Christ died for our sins, just as the Scriptures said. He was buried, and he was raised from the dead on the third day, just as the Scriptures said."

Jonah thanks God for saving him. What should be our response to God saving us?

1 Peter 1:3 - "All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is by his great mercy that we have been born again, because God raised Jesus Christ from the dead."

Colossians 3:16-17 - "Let the message about Christ, in all its richness, fill your lives. Teach and counsel each other with all the wisdom he gives. Sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs to God with thankful hearts. And whatever you do or say, do it as a representative of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through him to God the Father."

What happens when we search for God and love His salvation? (Also, look where joy and gladness are found!)

Psalms 40:16 - "But may all who search for you be filled with joy and gladness in you. May those who love your salvation repeatedly shout, "The LORD is great!""
