Philippians 2:7-8 - "Instead, he [Jesus] gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being. When he appeared in human form, he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross."  List all the things Jesus did as stated in these verses (hint: there are 5 things).

John 3:16 - ""For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life."  What does this verse tell us about God? What does it tell us about Jesus? What does it tell us about us?
Have you ever needed or wanted something that you couldn't get for yourself, that someone else like your mom or dad or grandparent gave to you as a gift? Maybe it was a bicycle, a trip to somewhere nice, or a pet?
